### COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT LAUNCH EVENT

We had a fantastic launch event on the 18<sup>th</sup> October and it was wonderful to have so many people come to find out about the Neighbourhood Plan. **Thank you** to everyone who came and saw us!

We had a fantastic response from the children at Barnham Broom Primary School, who submitted art work, writing and poems to represent what Barnham Broom means to them. Prizes and certificates have been awarded, following the voting on the day.

A massive **thank you** to the wonderful Community Fund, who supported our launch event by providing delicious refreshments.

### FUNDRAISING

The main expense to create a Neighbourhood Plan is Consultant Fees. Following quotes, and based on the Working Group taking on as much as possible, we're looking at around £11,000 in costs to produce a Neighbourhood Plan. We will be applying for a grant of £6,000 from South Norfolk Council, with the remaining £5,000 needing to be raised ourselves.

So far we have raised a total of £1,284.39 from a combination of our table top at the Yard Sale, the raffle at the launch event as well as donations, including the wonderfully kind and generous donation from the Tucker's firework display.

We've got lots of exciting plans coming up, so do keep an eye out for our fundraising events. We're also hoping to start a **100 Club** lottery, if we can get enough interest. If you'd like to register your interest please contact us.

### WORKING WITH THE PARISH COUNCIL

We're working closely with the Parish Council to formalise our working arrangements and governance.

At the last Parish Council meeting (23<sup>rd</sup> October) they formally agreed to the neighbourhood plan boundaries. It is now for the Clerk to submit these to South Norfolk Council for designation.
